To receive the best outcomes from the program, it is recommended that patients are referred to the Day Rehabilitation program following diagnosis, to allow for a specialist therapy plan to be put in place to support you through your journey.

Following cancer treatment, an Inpatient stay is recommended to recondition you and get you back on your feet. Our Inpatient program is approximately two weeks in duration.
